OfficerComments -

Dick Walsh requested a moment of silence to respect the passing during 2018 of past CCV Captain Jerry Ramsey and 2008 Chairman Jim Wade.

Treasurer DickWalsh reported a 2018 year-end account balance of \$3,338.26, a profit year to year of \$513.91. All clubs were within \$40 of balancing their events financially and all but three were in the black. Of course these figures do not account

for the logo balls, (\$25 per dozen). Captains were reminded to negotiate fees and, for example, try to set lunch charges commensurate with the meals served.

Old Business –

Cancellation policy. To avoid being charged the full fee,a player must cancel no later than noon the day before an event except in cases where the host captain agrees to waive the fee. All other cancellations that cause commitment shortfall will be charged the \$5 prize fee.

Except for host clubs for which we collect \$60 per player, visiting captains are responsible for the \$5 per individual shortfall fee.

The \$60 clubs will be Hermitage, Salisbury and CCV. All other clubs will be \$50

Rosters should be provided to host captains at least a week before an event.

• New Business –

The new rule is adopted whereby for a lost or out-of-bounds ball the player will drop a ball in the fairway and proceed after a penalty of two strokes. The triple bogic maximum rule is still in force.

GRSMGA events are tournaments

Except in cases approved by the visiting captain, cart path restrictions are not valid reasons for late cancellations.
